Take assessment test and submit official transcripts

- The assessment test provides placement information for math and English courses and may be required for some technical classes or programs. Please visit www.lwtc.edu/assessment for testing information.
- To transfer credit from a previous college, military training, or AP/IB, request official transcripts and either bring them in or have them sent to Enrollment Services. Evaluations take 2-3 weeks with results posted to your transcript.

Apply for Financial Aid

- Financial Aid is available for qualified students. To be considered for full funding, apply early. Fill out the free application online at www.fafsa.ed.gov and visit the Financial Aid website at www.lwtc.edu/financialaid for more information about financial aid requirements and deadlines. 2009-2010 WAIVERS*

Basic Skills—Adult Basic Education, English as a Second Language, and GED preparation	Waives \$25 course fee. Form Available in Enrollment Services (W201)
Child of Deceased/Disabled Law Enforcement Officer or Firefighter	Waives tuition and fees.
Veterans	Waives 25% of tuition and fees. Bring copy of DD214 to Enrollment Services (W201.)
Children and Spouse of Totally Disabled or POW/MIA or Deceased Eligible Veterans or National Guard Members	Waives tuition and fees. Form Available in Enrollment Services (W201).
Vocational Students Enrolled in over 18 credits	Student only pays \$6.80 for credits over 18 (comprehensive, facilities, safety/security fees)
Senior Citizen (Audit)	Must be over 60 years old. Space available waiver. \$5 registration fee plus class fees—limit 2 classes. Form Available in Enrollment Services (W201)
Senior Citizen (Credit)	Must be over 60 years old. Space available waiver. Waives 35% tuition—limit 2 classes. Form Available in Enrollment Services (W201)
Washington State Employee	Space available waiver. \$5 registration fee and \$6.80 per credit tuition plus class fees. Form Available in Enrollment Services (W201).
Non-Resident Tuition Differential	Waiver of nonresident operating fee differential. Available to US Citizens and Permanent Residents. Student pays a maximum of \$13 more per credit than resident tuition.
