## Financial Aid Reminders!

- Students who pick up a financial aid check but withdraw from classes on or after the 5<sup>th</sup> business day of the quarter may owe a repayment to a federal or state aid program.
- Students must attend classes for which they receive aid. Students who do not attend all of the classes for which they have received aid may owe a repayment to a federal or state aid program. **A student who receives a grade of "Z", "0.0", "N", "NG", "U", or "W" will be assumed to have not attended the class unless documentation is provided by the student otherwise. Students may receive a bill for aid repayment after grades are posted if attendance cannot be documented.**
- Students must maintain satisfactory academic progress to continue to receive financial aid. The satisfactory academic progress policy may be viewed or printed from the financial aid website [www.lwtc.edu/financialaid](http://www.lwtc.edu/financialaid) (select "Financial Aid Forms"), or viewed in the college catalog under "Financial Aid".
- Students may only receive aid for courses that are required for their program.
- ABED classes and ESL classes are not eligible for financial aid.
- Students are initially awarded based on full-time attendance. Grant aid will be adjusted for students attending less than full-time. Students must be enrolled at least half-time in classes that are required for their program to receive student loans or participate in work study. Enrollment levels are listed below:

Full-time: 12 credits  
Three-quarter time: 9 – 11 credits  
Half-time: 6 – 8 credits  
Less than half-time: 5 or less credits
