### Driving Directions

#### From LWTC Kirkland campus (5.4 miles)

- Turn right from college onto 132nd Ave. NE
- Turn left on NE Redmond Way (NE 85th St.)
- Turn right on Cleveland St.
- Bear right on Redmond Way
- Turn right on NE 70th St. at Brown Bear Car Wash
- Turn left on 176th Ave. NE
- Go to the end of the street. The campus is on the right overlooking Marymoor Park

#### From I-405

- Take exit #18, NE 85th St. and head east toward Redmond
- Turn right onto W. Lake Sammamish Way NE at the sign shaped like a bicycle
- Merge onto 520 E. toward Fall City/North Bend
- Take the 202 E. exit toward Fall City/North Bend
- Take a slight right onto Redmond Way
- Turn right onto NE 70th St. at the Brown Bear Car Wash
- Turn left onto 176th Ave. NE
- Go to the end of the street. The campus is on the right overlooking Marymoor Park



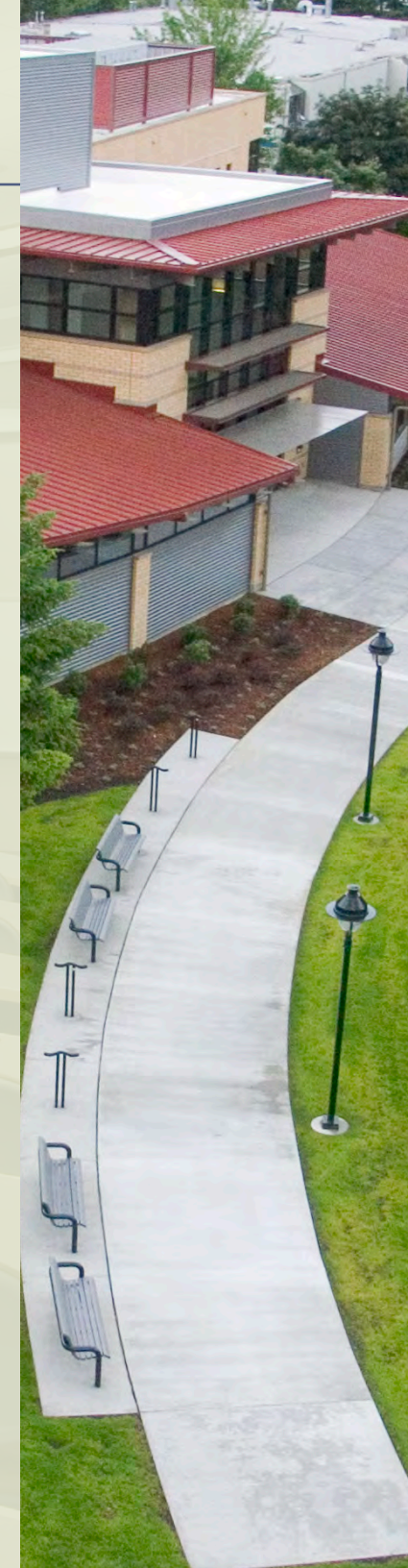

## Redmond Campus

Situated between Marymoor Park and an industrial park, the Redmond campus reflects the aesthetic beauty of the site while respecting the modern context of Redmond as a center for industry and, most recently, cutting-edge technology.

The central two-level lobby focuses on the adjacent park and provides informal space both inside and outside the building. The large two-story element responds to the industrial scale of the neighboring structures and forms the northern half of the composition.

The Redmond campus building is the first building in the city constructed to meet LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) standards. LEED buildings are highly energy efficient which lowers operating costs. It was recognized in May,

2006 by the U.S. Green Buildings Council as the first among all buildings of the state's two-year institutions to have achieved LEED Silver Certification.

The Redmond Campus Corporate Learning Center offers a variety of services including credit and non-credit classes, corporate and conference services and customized training.
