Our MMDP evening/hybrid multimedia A.A.S. program meets the needs of working adults by allowing them to earn a degree in eight quarters by attending at night and online.

### What's the MMDP evening/hybrid program?

The evening/hybrid program in Multimedia Design & Production provides a flexible schedule for students who are pursuing their A.A.S. degree while continuing to work during the day. Most classes meet face-to-face once a week, with the remainder of the coursework online, allowing for less commute time and more convenience for busy schedules.

### What skills will I gain?

The A.A.S. in Multimedia Design & Production prepares students to work in a variety of settings as graphic designers, web designers, desktop publishers, and graphic arts technicians. Graduates will be able to plan, analyze, and create visual solutions to produce web sites, printed materials, and interactive online experiences.

### When can I start, and how long will it take me to get my degree?

Students can enroll in the program any quarter. Fall-start students can complete their AAS degree in just eight quarters. The night program is not currently available for animation or interactive digital media students.



### Can I take an evening/hybrid class along with day classes?

Any student in any of the MMDP programs is welcome to take

the evening hybrid courses as part of their coursework.

### Where are the classes held?

Classes are held at LWTC's Kirkland Campus in the spacious and contemporary Technology Center, equipped with state-of-the-art computers and the latest software, including the Adobe Creative Suite.
