MULTIMEDIA DESIGN & PRODUCTION

How will an LWTC multimedia degree or certificate help my career?

The Multimedia Design & Production (MMDP) program features top-notch instruction by industry-experienced teaching professionals on state-of-the-art computers. The program has three available tracks, leading to associate of applied science degrees (A.A.S.) or certificates. Graduates are prepared to work as entry-level designers and production artists in a variety of settings.

What options are available?

Animation Game Design

This degree prepares students to create animated graphics applicable to: gaming marketing, advertising, educational, and various other types of interactive media that use 3D animation. The program has a strong emphasis on game development.

Video and Web Production

This degree prepares students to design and author interactive media for training DVDs, produce streaming media content, develop and maintain interactive web sites and design and output various marketing materials. It has a strong emphasis on pre- and post-production skills. Graduates are able to operate studio equipment, edit audio and video, and plan and manage production projects.

Multimedia Design & Production

This degree prepares students to work in a variety of settings as graphic designers, web designers, desktop publishers, and graphic art technicians. Graduates will be able to plan, analyze, and create visual solutions to produce web sites, printed materials, and interactive online experiences.

Certificate options

Certificates of completion are intended as technical skill upgrades for industry workers and require

one or two quarters to complete. Certificates of proficiency include both theory and computer courses and can generally be completed in four quarters.

Can I earn a bachelor degree?

LWTC is proud to be the first technical college in Washington State to offer a Bachelor of Technology in Applied Design. Graduates of the MMDP program are eligible to apply. More information is available at: www.lwtc.edu/btad

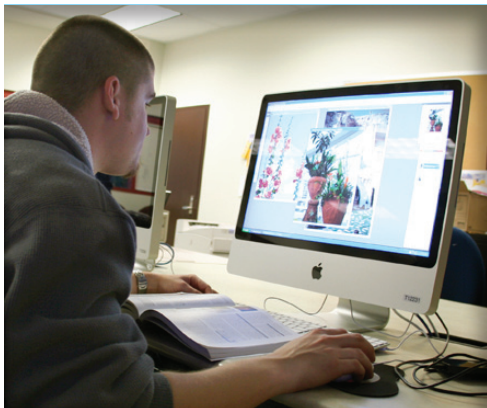
