Bachelor's Degree:

LWTech's Digital Gaming & Interactive Media Bachelor's degree is the first degree of its kind in the state of Washington offered by a public institution. Students can transfer to LWTech's bachelor's degree in Digital Gaming & Interactive Media program with an associate degree in a variety of design fields including Digital Gaming & Interactive Media, and graphic design. Students study and learn in a simulated team-based game development environment.

Associate Degree:

The Digital Gaming & Interactive Media AAS-T degree at LWTech teaches students game development and design. Students gain skills in digital storytelling, character development, and technical and creative design. Graduates create 3D animated

graphics for gaming, marketing, educational and interactive media. LWTech Digital Gaming students culminate their learning experience with a showcase of their portfolio to industry professionals.
