Application Requirements

Admission criteria for the Bachelor of Applied Science in Funeral Service Education reflects an approach that includes the student's academic record, personal characteristics, and potential to work in the Funeral service field. Applicants are admitted for a Fall quarter start. Please follow all directions in this application carefully. Missing steps in the process described within may result in disqualification from the admissions pool for this program.



Application Requirements

- Graduate of an ABFSE accredited Funeral Service Program.
- Ability to sit for the ICFSEB National Board Exam (NBE)
- Minimum 2.5 GPA cumulative across all college coursework.

Applicants must have earned an Applied Associate Degree, Direct Transfer Associate Degree from a regionally accredited institution, ABFSE accredited Funeral Service Program to be eligible to apply.

Required Courses for Application

The listed requirements must be met before filling out the admission application for the BAS in Funeral Service Education

Completion of 15 credits of General Education from the list below with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA in each class.

- English Composition - 5 credits: ENGL&101 or equivalent
- Any Social Sciences - 5 credits: college level course
- Quantitative & Symbolic Reasoning – 5 credits: MATH&107 or equivalent course with Intermediate Algebra as its prerequisite
- Any Humanities - 5 credits: college-level course
- Natural Science with Lab - 5 credits of college-level course

Students must have a 15 credits of the above courses completed at the time of admission.
