Summer & Fall Quarters Advising

We continue to enroll students for Summer & Fall quarters. Please use the links, listed below in this newsletter, to schedule an appointment with your high school advisor.

We are not funded for Summer quarter, however students may elect to take classes, at their own expense, at a substantial discount from regular college tuition. A summer scholarship application is available, too. Speak with your Advisor about details.

Variance Attendance Release

Every school year Academy students are required to submit a new variance attendance release form. This is what allows you to attend LWTA in our district. At your registration appointment you will receive a variance attendance form that you will need to take to your home district office. A copy of it is also attached to this email. The **designated district official** is required to sign, and students need to return the signed form back to our office. If you do not turn this in, you will not be permitted to attend the 2021-2022 school year. The last day to submit the variance attendance release form is June 25th.

Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) Update

Students in Washington state will not take the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) this Spring, according to a recent decision communicated by State Superintendent Chris Reykdal. Students who were intending to use the SBA as part of their graduation pathway in 2021 should consult with their advisor about alternatives.

Skyward Family Access

Our high school uses Skyward, a system that parents and guardians have access allowing them to view their student's information and important dates during our academic year. Through Skyward, we also communicate important messages regarding school closures, events and reminders. Once you've received access and logged in, parent and/or guardians are **required** to review and update student information at the beginning of each school year. This also allows families to update student demographics if needed. We appreciate your participation as this opportunity is only open until October 30th, 2018. Failure to update your record will disqualify you from being served by this school district.
