Application Requirements

- Applied Associate Degree, or equivalent, from an accredited institution in a business or transportation related field.
- Minimum 2.0 GPA cumulative across all college coursework.

Required Courses for Application

The following requirements must be met before filling out the admission application for the TLSCM BAS program

- Completion of at least 15 credits of General Education from the list below with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA in each class:
 - English Composition: 5 credits
 - ENGL& 101 or equivalent
 - Quantitative Reasoning: 5 credits
 - College level math course with Intermediate Algebra as a prerequisite or higher
 - Social Sciences: 5 credits
 - Humanities: 5 credits
 - Natural Sciences: 10 Credits
 - Must include one course (5 credits) with lab

Official Transcripts documenting all prerequisite courses must be sent to LWTech Enrollment Services office. Students must have a minimum of 15 credits of the above courses completed at the time of admission. Students who have courses to complete at the time of admission may be admitted conditionally.

Application Requirements

This degree has an academic bridge component that may be completed after admission but prior to entering the first quarter of program coursework. This allows students to complete general education coursework that may not have been taken in the course of completing the Associate level degree in their discipline. We encourage all applicants to work with an advisor in planning their path to applying to the BAS-TLSCM. LWTech offers coursework in the summer to facilitate student completion of the academic bridge courses.

1. Applicants must have earned an Applied Associate Degree, Direct Transfer Associate Degree, or equivalent from an accredited* institution in a business or transportation-related field to be eligible to apply.
 - Degree equivalency is defined as completion of at least 90 or more college-level credits that minimally include 5 credits each of college-level written communication, Math, and Social Science at an accredited* institution (or international equivalent).



Checking Application Status

You will receive an admissions decision within **3 weeks after the deadline** from the Selective Admissions Office

- You can check on the progress of your admission decision status by logging into your Self-Service Center.
- Requirement status will be updated manually, when admission staff process and verifies your application documents.
