## 3. Register

### Help us determine your English and Math Placement

#### Option 1: New to college?

- Visit the Assessment Center to take a free Placement Assessment: [LWTech.edu/Assessment](https://www.lwtech.edu/assessment)
- Drop-in seating on Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Friday at 8 a.m. to 1p.m. (last seating at 1 p.m.)
- A picture identification and SID is required.

#### Option 2: Already have existing college credits?

- Obtain a copy of your assessment score or unofficial transcript in order to place you in classes or If you are formally transferring credits, contact your previous college(s) and request official transcripts to be mailed to:
  - LWTech, Enrollment Services, 11605 132nd Ave NE, Kirkland WA 98034
  - OR send an official e-transcript to [Admissions@LWTech.edu](mailto:Admissions@LWTech.edu)
- College credits from outside the US? You must have your transcript evaluated. Go to [LWTech.edu/International](https://www.lwtech.edu/international) to see a list of International Credential Evaluation Agencies.

#### Option 3: Recently graduated from High School?

- If you graduated in the past 2 years, you can send your high school transcripts to Enrollment Services (see above info about sending in transcripts).

### Make an Appointment with a Navigator

- Student ID# needed: (425) 739-8300.
- A Navigator will help you choose classes, review unofficial/official transcripts, review assessment scores, create your academic plan, and register you for classes if the registration window is open.
- Items to bring to your appointment: transcript(s) and/or placement assessment scores.
