



Scholarship Program Guidelines – Applications Due April 29th, 2021

If you are choosing to participate in the Windermere Foundation Scholarship Program, there are a few guidelines we'd like you to be aware of.

While the criteria for awarding scholarship funds are based on an individual's financial need and community service, often times a student with the most need is unable to volunteer his or her time because of the necessity of holding a paying job, or the responsibility of caring for siblings. Therefore, we look at the entire situation to determine our scholarship decisions.

Please note the guidelines for awarding scholarship funds:

- * Need based
- * Community Service
- * In-state ONLY (public or private)
- * The amount of the award is \$1,500.00 per individual
- * Windermere agents, managers, employees and their family members are not eligible for Scholarship awards

The Windermere Foundation Scholarship is designed to encourage and recognize eligible students who show determination in seeking to continue their education, in conjunction with contributing to society through various forms of community service, especially in regard to the homeless or those at risk of becoming homeless. Priority is given to those students who themselves are at risk financially and without the help of the Foundation might not continue their education. Students need not attend a four year college or university to receive this scholarship; any form of continuing education will be considered for the scholarship. It is the Foundation's belief that continued education is but one of the ways we at the Foundation can contribute to the eradication of homelessness in our community.
