

Tuition Waiver: Child or Spouse of Disabled/Deceased/ MIA/POW Veteran

ELIGIBILITY: Students receive a waiver of all tuition and fees if a parent or spouse was an eligible veteran or National Guard member who:

- 1. Became totally disabled as defined in RCW 28B.15.385; or
- 2. Lost his or her life while engaged in active federal military or naval service; or
- 3. Is determined by the federal government to be a prisoner of war or missing in action.

CONDITIONS: To qualify for this waiver:

- 1. The child must be a Washington Domiciliary between the age of seventeen (17) and twenty-six (26). A child's marital status does not affect eligibility.
- 2. The surviving spouse must be a Washington Domiciliary. A surviving spouse has ten years from the date of the death, total disability, or federal determination of prisoner of war or missing in action status to receive this benefit. Upon remarriage, the surviving spouse is ineligible for the waiver.
- 3. Students must <u>not</u> be enrolled in fee-based courses or programs.

PROCEDURES: Complete the application below and attach documentation showing:

- 1. Proof of qualifying military service (such as a DD-214),
- 2. Proof of death or disability while engaged in active federal military of naval service,
- 3. Copy of a birth certificate or marriage certificate,
- 4. Proof of student Washington Domiciliary, and
- 5. Proof of qualifying parent's or spouse's Washington Domiciliary.
