- STEP 1:** Attend Workforce Development orientation  
All Workforce Development students must attend orientation. To see which program you may qualify for and to register for the workshop, please visit [www.lwtech.edu/WFD](http://www.lwtech.edu/WFD) and click the link that says "Please click here to take our Start Next Quarter Survey". At the conclusion of the survey, you can register for the orientation.

**Sessions are held every Wednesday in W305B at 12:00 PM. The orientation lasts an hour and half.**

- STEP 2:** Apply for admission to LWTech

- STEP 3:** Apply for [Financial Aid](#) & turn in all supplemental paperwork  
The primary way students pay for tuition is through federal financial aid. To apply, go to [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).  
**Don't forget to turn your supplemental paperwork in after you've completed your FAFSA!**

- STEP 4:** Take the [self-guided placement assessment](#) or submit [transcripts](#)  
Please do one of the following, based on your college history:
- A. **Take the Self-guided Placement Assessment:** No appointment is necessary to take the assessment. All assessments are administered in the West Building, Room W204. Bring a government issued photo ID & your LWTech Student ID number with you.

**Assessment Times: Mondays: 8-2 PM, Tuesdays: 8-2PM, Wednesdays: 8-2PM, Fridays: 10-2 PM**

**OR**

- B. **Transcripts:** Students may use unofficial transcripts for initial planning purposes. Students may need to submit official transcripts if transferring credits.

- STEP 5:** Attend New Student Orientation  
[New Student Orientation](#) is **mandatory** for new students without previous college credit. All students must either attend orientation **or** show transcripts to an advisor in W207 in order to register for classes.

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## **STEP 6:** Academic Planning

Students will meet with a Workforce Development Advisor to review degree or certificate requirements, plan their course of study, and select their first quarter classes. You will register for an Academic Planning session at the Workforce Development Orientation.
