Joint Commission on National Dental Examinations Part I, II and Dental Hygiene Examination

1. The website is <http://www.ada.org/2667.aspx> for Part 1 of the National Board Dental Examination.
2. Candidates must obtain a DENTPIN before applying for the examination.
3. Candidates can print the "National Board Exam Accommodation Request" form at http://www.ada.org/sections/educationAndCareers/pdfs/nb_accommodation_request.pdf.
4. Candidates must submit an application to test, the testing accommodation request form and the supporting documentation at nbexams@ada.org.
5. A testing appointment can be scheduled after testing accommodation request has been approved.
6. Candidates have to fill out the "Accommodation Request" form carefully.
7. A current evaluation report (within the past 5 years) from the appropriate licensed professional must be included.
8. Candidates should read the "unacceptable forms of documentation for request for accommodation" section carefully. No handwritten letters, patient records, notes from patient charts. Diagnoses on prescription pads, etc. will be accepted.

2. Candidates can print the "National Board Exam Accommodation Request" form at <http://wreb.org/Candidates/Dental/dentalPDFs/2012SpecialAccommodations.pdf>.
3. Candidates fill out the first page and the evaluator fills out the second page.
4. Documentation must be less than 3 years old and the evaluators should be qualified. Candidates should read the "Accommodation Request" form carefully.
5. The information would need to be mailed to WREB no later than 45 days prior to the exam.
