

## Funeral Services Education

### National Board (Arts and Sciences exam)

1. The website is <http://www.theconferenceonline.org/WAexammaterials.shtml>.
2. Candidates download the application at [http://ftp.theconferenceonline.org/documents/WASBEApplication\\_001.pdf](http://ftp.theconferenceonline.org/documents/WASBEApplication_001.pdf).
3. The first page will have a checkbox for candidates requesting accommodations. The form requires the candidate to state the nature of the disability and the specific accommodations being requested.
4. The second page, under number 6, explains what needs to be submitted. "The ADA Examination Accommodation Request Form" along with current written support documentation (within 3 years) from a qualified health professional.
5. The form can be found at <http://www.theconferenceonline.org/documents/ADAform.pdf>.
6. The first section is completed by the candidate and the second section is completed by a qualified health professional.
7. A copy of the accommodations provided by LWIT can be provided by the DSS office.
8. "The ADA Examination Accommodation Request Form" and supporting documentation must be submitted with your application.
9. Please note: You won't be required to take the Funeral Arts exam and/or the Embalmer Sciences exam if you have passed the National Board Exam with an average score of 75% or better or have passed another state's Funeral Arts and the Embalmer Sciences Exam.
