

## Massage Therapy

### National Board

1. The website is <http://www.ncbtmb.org/>. Students can download the applications for the national certifications at [http://www.ncbtmb.org/applicants\\_forms.php](http://www.ncbtmb.org/applicants_forms.php).
2. Students can request accommodations by completing Section 1 of the "ADA Accommodations Request Form" at <http://www.ncbtmb.org/pdf/ADAAccommodation.pdf/>.
3. You will also need a letter from the appropriate professional for Section 3, detailing the specific nature of your disability as it relates to the request and the reasons for requesting the accommodation. The NCBTMB requests that this letter be dated no more than five (5) years prior to this Application.  
  
\*\*Note: In the candidate handbook under Accommodations for Candidates with Disabilities, it mentions that the letter from the appropriate professional will not be accepted by fax. Yet in the "ADA Accommodations Request Form" it says that fax is preferred. Faxes will be accepted.
4. Complete and mail in your "ADA Accommodations Request Form" with your Application. The "ADA Accommodations Request Form" must be submitted with your application.
5. There is no additional charge for special accommodations.

### Massage State License

2. Complete the Jurisprudence Exam online. There is no time limit and must pass with 100%.
3. You must print out the completion page at the end of the exam and submit it with your application.
4. Complete and mail in the "Massage License Application". Separate documentation not included in the Application will also need to be mailed to a separate location (explained in the Application).
