<b>Evaluation of Web Documents</b>	How to interpret the basics		
Accuracy of Web Documents	Accuracy		
<ul> <li>Is the person qualified to write this document?</li> <li>What is the purpose of the document or why was it produced?</li> <li>Does the information compliment other forms of information that you have found?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Is the person who wrote site an expert in this field?</li> <li>Does the information on site parallel similar information from other sources (or does it say something completely random that you cannot verify elsewhere)?</li> </ul>		
Authority of Web Documents	Authority		
<ul> <li>Who published the documents?</li> <li>Check the domain of the document, what institution published it?</li> <li>Does the publisher list his/her qualifications?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>What credentials are listed for the authors?</li> <li>Make sure the author provides contact information</li> <li>Know the difference between author and webmaster</li> <li>Where is the document published (check the URL)?</li> </ul>		
Objectivity of Web Documents	Objectivity		
<ul><li>What goals/objectives does the page meet?</li><li>How detailed is the information?</li><li>What opinions (if any) are expressed?</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Determine if the page is a mask for advertising (might be biased)</li> <li>Ask yourself "why was this written and for whom?"</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>When was it produced?</li> <li>When was it updated?</li> <li>How up-to-date are the links?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>How many dead links are on the page</li> <li>Are the links current and updated?</li> <li>Is the information outdated and does current date matter for your topic?</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Are the links evaluated and do they complement the theme of the site</li> <li>Is there a good balance of text and images</li> <li>Is the information presented correctly cited?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>If page requires special software to view, how much are you missing if you don't have the software?</li> <li>Is the information free to obtain?</li> <li>Is the information backed up with or by responsible sources?</li> </ul>
