

DSJ Book Review Instructions

We are so happy you want to write a book review for a book from our DSJ collection! This will help others discover titles to read and create a conversation among our community regarding DSJ topics.

Follow these steps to write the review.

1. Choose a review card format.
Review cards can be done in one of two formats; 1) as a card that will be inserted into the book, or 2) as a table tent that will be displayed on the shelf near the book. Choose your preferred format.
2. Fill out title and author fields
3. Write a summary of the book. You can summarize the book in any way that is meaningful to you. For the paper version of the review, you may only be able to fit a few sentences. If you want to write a longer review, you have the option of using our electronic [DSJ Book Review Form](#). The electronic reviews will be linked to the DSJ Collection on the library webpage.
4. Write a personal reflection of how this book relates to or is meaningful to you and your life. How you choose to write this is completely open-ended. Sharing your personal experience helps others see the value of the book and will help as grow as a community.
5. Add your name to the Reviewer field. (optional)
6. Fill in the sign-in sheet on the library shelves with your name and title of book you reviewed. (optional)
